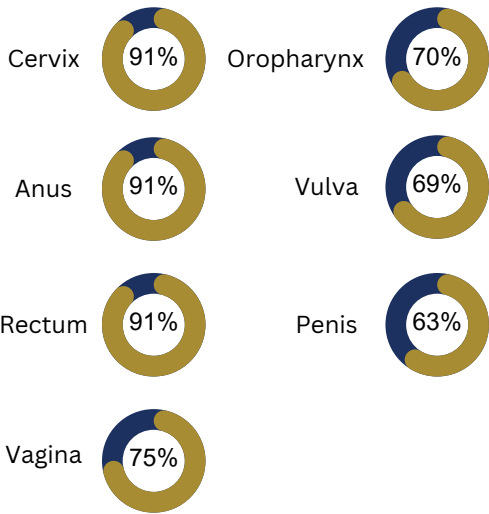


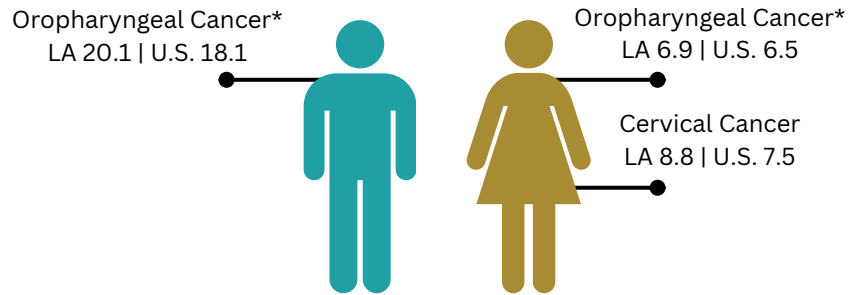

Percentage of Cancers Probably Caused by HPV

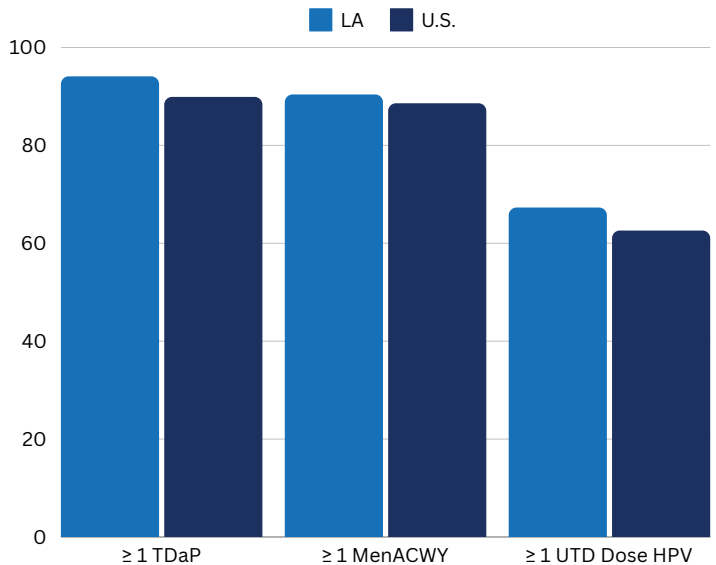


HPV causes nearly all cervical cancers and many cancers of the vagina, vulva, penis, anus, rectum and oropharynx.

HPV, Tdap and MenACWY Vaccination Coverage Percentage among Adolescents 13-17 Years (2022)

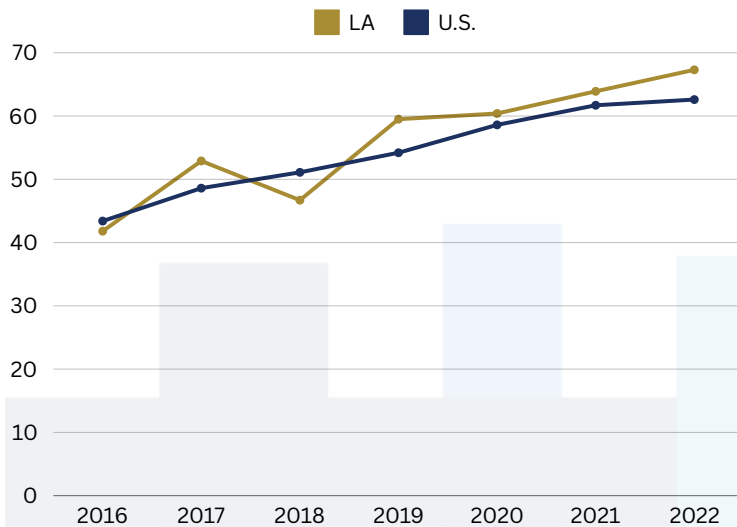


On average from 2016-2020, 737 Louisianans were diagnosed with HPV-related cancers

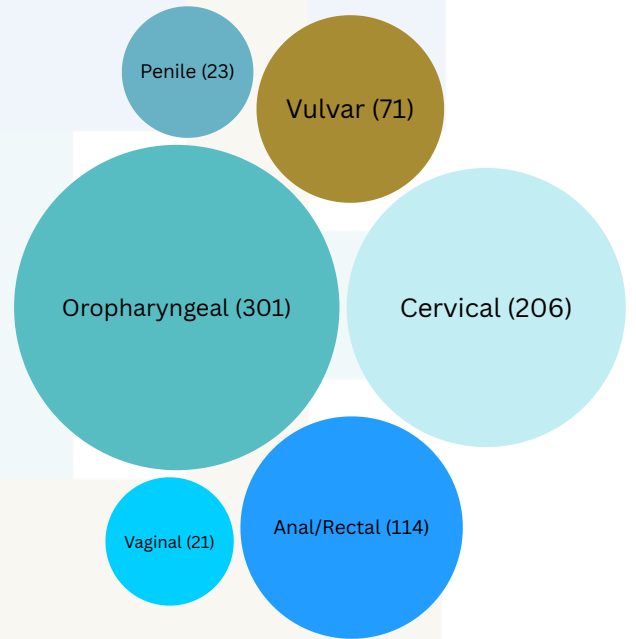

HPV Vaccination Coverage Percentage by Year Among Adolescent 13-17 Years Old

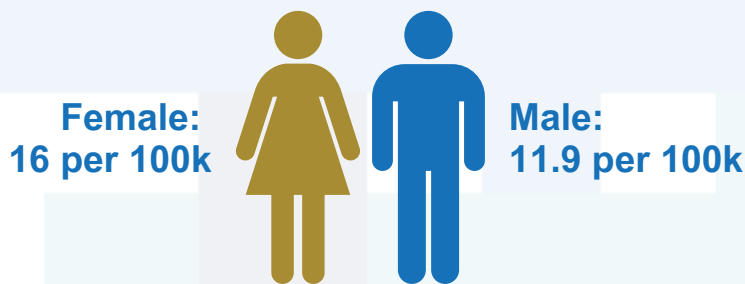


Of the 6 types of cancers associated with HPV, 79% of those were most likely caused by HPV
